19 The motion of plaintiff Amber Coyle (“Plaintiff”) for an order granting preliminary approval of  
20 the class action settlement (the “Settlement”) reached with defendant Mosaic Sales Solutions US  
21 Operating Co., LLC (“Defendant”) came regularly on for hearing. Good cause having been shown,  
22 Plaintiff’s motion is GRANTED and IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

23 1. The Court finds that all the requirements for class certification under Section 382 of the  
24 Code of Civil Procedure are satisfied with respect to, and preliminarily certifies for settlement  
25 purposes, a settlement class comprised of all persons who worked for Defendant in California as a  
26 brand ambassador and/or product demonstrator at any time between August 27, 2015 and June 30,  
27 2021 (the “Settlement Class”).

28 2. The Court appoints Plaintiff as class representative of the Settlement Class for the  
purposes of settlement.

1 3. The Court appoints Peter M. Hart of the Law Offices of Peter M. Hart as class counsel  
2 for the Settlement Class for the purposes of settlement.

3 4. The Court appoints Atticus Administration as the Settlement Administrator.

4 5. The Court preliminarily approves the Settlement as fair and reasonable and finds that  
5 the manner for providing class members notice of the Settlement comports with Rule 3.766 of the  
6 California Rules of Court and the requirements of due process.

7 6. The Court approves the form and content of the proposed Notice attached as Exhibit A  
8 to the Settlement and directs mailing by the Settlement Administrator of the Notice by first class mail  
9 to the class members in accordance with the Settlement.

10 7. The Court orders that, in accordance with the Settlement, class members shall have 45  
11 days after mailing of the Notice to make objections to the Settlement or request exclusion from the  
12 Settlement.

13 8. The Court orders that, in accordance with the Settlement, any class member who  
14 submits a valid and timely request to be excluded from the Settlement shall no longer be a member of  
15 the class, shall be barred from participating in the Settlement; shall have no right to object to the  
16 Settlement; and shall receive no benefit from the Settlement.

17 9. The Court schedules a Final Approval Hearing for Revised: 09/07/2022, 2022 at  
18 FOUCAE E.

19 10. The Court orders that Plaintiff shall serve and file a motion for final approval of the  
20 Settlement at least 16 court days before the Final Approval Hearing.
